

HISTORY

As part of a bid to win a National Hockey League franchise for Ottawa, Terrance Corporation unveiled a proposal for a new arena at a press conference in September 1989. Land was acquired on the western boarder of Kanata in May 1989.

The arena's architectural design was inspired by The Palace of Auburn Hills in Auburn Hills, Michigan. Both designed by Detroit-based architects Rossetti Architects.

Once financing was in place, construction took 18-months, finishing on January 18, 1996, with a concert from Bryan Adams. The first NHL game took place two days later with the Ottawa Senators playing the Montreal Canadiens.

Today, the venue brings in world-class entertainment, hosts exciting hockey games and home to a new National Lacrosse League team, the Ottawa Black Bears.



TECH MANUAL

STAGE

Stage Right ME500
Max size 72' W x 48' D
Adjustable from 48" to 78"
Three sets of adjustable stairs
120 linear feet of toe rail and handrail.

There is no lagging into the deck unless plywood is available or supplied.
Accessible ramp available for 4' stage only.

MIX PLATFORM

All area sizes available Height adjustable 12" or 24"

BARRICADE

112' feet long

- Free standing with sound "blow thru" panels
- Full black skirting
- No corner pieces

ARENA FLOOR

- 200 feet x 85 feet
- 17,000 square feet
- 218 feet x 85 feet with the west end risers retracted
- 500 lbs / square foot of load capacity. Smooth concrete.

HOUSE LIGHTING

- Ephesus LED 300 watt arena lighting
- Ephesus LED 600 watt series arena lighting Spot lights
- Six Lycian M2 long throw 2500 watts
- 10 positions available on the catwalk
- All wired for clear com intercom



TECH MANUAL

Show power

All power is located upstage centre of the left and right side of the Zamboni tunnel The cable run is approximately 50' to the upstage edge and 155' to the FOH mix location

- (1) 1500 amp splitter 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire with the following disconnects:
- (2) 100 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire 1 200 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire 2 400 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire
- (2) 60 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire rigging power
- (1) 1500 amp splitter 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire with the following disconnects:
- (2) 200 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire 4 400 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire

Shore power (inside)

- (1) 800 amp splitter 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire with the following disconnects:
- (4) 200 amp 208 volt, 3 phase/4 wire 2 50 amp 120/208 volt

These may also be used as additional show power with a cable run of approximately 120' to the upstage edge

Shore power (outside)

Located outside of the loading dock entrance, 200 amp main breaker:

(6) 50 amp twist lock connections
